

Portfolio Report For Highways

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Comment

1. SID post on A371 Lower Ansford Hill – in the process of organising it to be moved onto Wyke land. The position chosen next to current post is not convenient for the new Estate and buildings. Wyke are looking and will let me know of a better position. That then needs clearance from SC Traffic Management
2. Hedge on A371 at corner of Station Road has been cut by Wyke so Pedestrians have clearer vision when crossing road. They have also cut back the 2nd part towards Station Bridge around the signs
3. A371 Ansford Hill Bank/Wall – funding and design confirmed at LCN Highways Mtg – potential for work to start end of September/October
4. At LCN mtg residents were encouraged to clear drains!! However no need for Chapter 8 training. Currently challenging the need for Chapter 8 training for SID to be moved around
5. Graffiti remover has been received – just looking to find time to walk around and clean signs where necessary – If anyone notices a sign in Ansford it would be very helpful if you could alert me to it for my list
6. Ansford Safety Focus Group – still collating info. Mtg held on 2nd March. External mtg report attached
7. 20mph school lights on Churchfield Drive reported as top light stuck on. Will chase this week.
8. A371 Lower Ansford Hill – SC cut hedge back but left a dangerous overhang that forces lorries into the road. Reported at LCN Highways mtg and Tracy Harris will look into
9. LCN Highways mtg attended:
Clanville drains repaired but still flooding due to a residents pond. Another resident has flooding which is related to new repairs – to be looked into by Highways-East
Sinkhole – Proposal that work will start end of March/beginning of April – a few more bits of investigation to be done before final work starts. Consideration for a diverted footpath for Pedestrians during road closure.
