1. Speedwatch – 2x outings on Churchfield Drive – recognised considerable speeding problems. Some may be in part to Sinkhole and closure of Station Road but when Persimmon homes are occupied it will be used as direct access to A371 and Ansford Academy. In order to introduce traffic calming we need evidence which will be collated with
 - a. contact from residents
 - b. Speedwatch recordings with Police
 - c. In process of arranging a New SID to be installed on bank of CC Bowls Club
2. 2x New SID's have arrived and have been programmed by a tech resident
New 85mm SID posts are expected to be installed in the next week
3. Sinkhole –Extended works to work to Elan Homes Estate so Station Road now opening approx. 31 J.
As of 1st June - Sinkhole – 21.5m wide and 4.5m deep
Pipe works starts today – 900mm diameter such it should never flood again
