## Comment

- the Scooter and Skateboard coaching day on 9 April was very successful. Councillor Henderson and I attended as Team Rubicon arrived to check that their DBS approval, registration documents, safety equipment and first aid kit etc were as per requirements. We also attended during the day to see how it was going and all were having a good time. 26 children attended with other children and parents in support. We are considering organising another day in the summer holidays – August 12 is the proposed date.
- Councillor Henderson; Councillor Houlton and I met with a representative from Yeovil Town Community Sports Trust (Yeovil Town Football Club) on 1<sup>st</sup> May to discuss them providing summer sports activities on the football field next to Caryford Hall.
